

Shaar Shalom Synagogue, (1971-2016) located in Thornhill, (Toronto) Ontario, Canada was founded originally by the local South African Jewish community and grew to be a vibrant multigenerational conservative congregation. The area's demographic change affected the synagogue's membership, with many moving to other congregations in the area. As membership and volunteer support waned, the synagogue closed its door on June 30, 2016.
