

## Csécse Jewish Cemetery

Csécse Jewish cemetery keys held by József Percze, Kodály Zoltán utca 24.

Any potential visitor to the Jewish cemetery in Csécse needs to plan their visit well in advance. It is unfortunate, but the inconsiderate and irreverent activities of a few visitors in the past has resulted in the permanent locking of the cemetery and the supervising authority and key holder now require the visitor to make an appointment to view. This is rather difficult for those who can neither write nor speak Hungarian. To avoid any disappointment, controversy or any local ill feeling however, it is nevertheless essential that the potential visitor firstly gets written permission to go to the site from an authority such as MAZSIHISZ, and then contacts the key holder to make an appointment.

The cemetery itself is rather remotely situated in the centre of an agricultural field. It is surrounded by a high wall and the visitor will be escorted by the key holder at all times. Inside, there is evidence of about 130 graves, but only about 100 headstones remain, some of which are only semi complete. The latter have been painstakingly re-erected by the key holder who has spent more than 30 years collecting the broken fragments and gluing them back where they rightfully belong. The site photos are a good indication of his dedication and the complexity of the task he has undertaken. In order to give three of the greatly valued headstones additional protection, two small brick buildings have also been constructed over them. Both buildings are also kept locked

The visitor will notice that some of the headstones also have reference numbers painted onto them. We are informed that these were done by MAZSIHISZ who keep their own record of them. When contacting Mazsihisz to make an appointment, it would be advisable to ask about that list as well.

Note; Up until the early 1950s, many Hungarian burial registers were printed with a box to declare a deceased's religion, but under the post war Communist regime there was no requirement to fill that section in. From that point onwards, it becomes more difficult to identify anyone from the community with a Jewish background and this record ceases at that point.
